Our reporting year end coincided with the arrival of Covid and ensured that all face to face activity had to be abandoned. The membership continued to be involved socially through an active whatsap group and were kept in touch with the running of the shed while we remained active in the South Lanarkshire Men's Shed Network via remote connections. The electronics group managed to stay active for a time by rotating experiments that could be carried out at home. The Board concentrated on making a bid to buy the former primary school at Walston. Our dealings with South Lanarkshire Council proved very slow and it took us till mid December to actually view the property. In January the Board formed a sub committee to progress the bid.

An Annual General Meeting was held via remote connections on November 3rd 2020 and the board was re-elected for another term. Sadly, in December we lost one of our founding members when Bob Kirkpatrick died.

In February we received a request from O.S.C.R. to amend our constitution to regularise remote participation in meetings. As we were by that time aware that we had lost a number of members for various reasons and had lost touch with others it was decided to re-register members. This reduced the membership to 21. The membership agreed the changes to the constitution unanimously via email.

In difficult circumstances we have managed to keep the majority of members engaged, informed and looking forward to resuming meetings, hopefully in more suitable premises.
